BOOK CONSIGNMENT PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in placing your book at All She Wrote Books, LLC. If your book has been published by an established publisher that we order from on a regular basis, and if we decide to carry it, we will purchase it directly from that source. If that is the case, there is no need for further action on your part, though you are welcome to send us notification of your book's publication by filling out this Google Form.

If your book is self-published, not readily available through our normal wholesalers, and/or is only available on a short discount/non-returnable basis, there may be an opportunity for us to sell it on consignment. Under consignment terms, the book remains the property of the consignor (the author) until sold. While we'd love to be able to support all indie authors, we have finite shelf space and as such stock a limited number of consignment titles each quarter.

All consignment requests must be made in writing, via this Google Form. Please do not email, call, or direct message the bookstore to inquire about the consignment program or to pitch your book.

All She Wrote Books, LLC, began as a pop-up bookstore and worked its way to a storefront, so we understand and respect the book business hustle. As well, we respect your time and the work it takes to write and promote a book(s). If we feel your book may have a market with our customers, we will contact you within two (2) weeks. **Please allow us the full two weeks to review and respond to your inquiry before following up.** If you must follow up, please do so in reply to your initial email or to the last correspondence you received from us to streamline information.

NOTE: We do not accept walk-in applications or review copy drop offs unless otherwise noted, as we need time to review your proposal.

If we are interested in considering your book for our shelves, we will request one (1) physical review copy. Please mail (no in-person drop offs) only if requested to:

All She Wrote Books, LLC, is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged merchandise. If you would like your book considered for stock, please review our consignment guidelines that will go into effect upon mutual agreement to stock:

- We require a \$20 non-refundable shelving fee (cash or check only) for each title accepted.
 This fee helps pay for the extra labor involved in putting your book on our website,
 tracking inventory, and issuing payments for each title.
- Upon acceptance, you must read and sign the Consignment Agreement form. If you are an established author with us, the shelving fee may be waived upon review.
- Standard consignment terms are as follows
 - All She Wrote Books, LLC, retains 40% of all profits made from the consignment sales; the remaining 60% of profits are returned to the author by cash or check only.
 - It is understood that the book will be sold at the same retail price across retailers, including at All She Wrote Books, LLC, and when sold through the author themselves.
 - We agree to stock the book for a minimum of 90 days but reserve the right to shorten or extend this period depending on sales or other factors.
 - Consignors are paid four (4) times a year: April, July, October, and January.
 - It is the author's responsibility to deliver new inventory and pick up unsold inventory. No compensation will be given to the consignor for unsold inventory.
 - Author(s) agree to promote All She Wrote as a retailer from which their books(s) may be purchased, on such platforms including but not limited to the author's website, Instagram, Twitter, TikTok, and Facebook.
 - All She Wrote Books, LLC, reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time, at which point unsold copies will be returned to the author/consignor without compensation to the consignor.

Whatever decision is made by our buyers is final. As with all inventory we carry in the store, we retain the right for any final decision not to carry a book if we believe it does not fit the store philosophy or our market.
